Award Recipients

The following is a summary of the allocation of CSHP NB Branch awards for 2007-2008.

Pfizer Pharmacy Residency Award

This award recognizes hospital pharmacy residents whose major projects are judged to be most deserving in terms of significant innovation, practical application, and/or development in an institutional pharmacy practice setting. It is a national award, administered in conjunction with the NS Branch of CSHP. One award is bestowed among the NS and NB hospital pharmacy residents. It consists of a cheque for \$1,000.00 and an engraved memento.

The recipient of the 2007 Pharmacy Residency Award was **Timothy MacLaggan**, who completed his residency at The Moncton Hospital. His project was titled "Identification of Learning Needs of Maritime Pharmacists". He is currently working as a clinical pharmacist in the Medical Surgical ICU at The Moncton Hospital.

Pharmacy Student Scholarships

The Pharmacy Student Scholarships are presented to two pharmacy students enrolled in one of the final two years of a Pharmacy degree (undergraduate or post-graduate) and who have demonstrated a marked interest in hospital pharmacy. The Scholarships consist of a bursary and a one year membership to CSHP. The amount of the bursary was increased from \$500.00 to \$1000.00 and I am pleased to report that this has increased interest among students, with four applications received this year. The recipients were **Erin Schwenger** and **Lindsay Lord**.

Erin Schwenger is a Pharmacy student from Bathurst enrolled at Memorial University of Newfoundland, where she completed her 3rd year.

Lindsay Lord is also from Bathurst and recently completed her Bachelor of Science in Pharmacy degree from Dalhousie University.

Professional Practice Conference Education Grants

Two grants of \$500.00 are offered by the NB Branch to members attending the PPC held in February of each year in Toronto. Recipients are selected by a draw.

This year's winners were **Karin Pickard** and **Janice Irvine-Meek**.

Pharmaceutical Partners of Canada Education Grants (to attend national AGM)

The PPC Education Grants are presented to two members of the NB Branch wishing to attend the national AGM held in August of every year. Applications are evaluated on the basis of Branch involvement and interest in becoming involved in future Branch activities. These grants, in the amount of \$1000.00 each, are possible through a donation from Pharmaceutical Partners of Canada.

This year, we initially only received one application, which was awarded to that individual. Subsequent to that, we extended the deadline for the remaining grant, which was awarded partially to two individuals, for a maximum of \$500.00 each.

Corry Clarke, Luke MacMaster and **Douglas Doucet** were the recipients and attended last summer's national AGM held in Regina, Saskatchewan from August 11-14, 2007.
