The CSHP Research and Education Foundation supports research and educational programs that advance pharmacy practice and patient care in hospitals and other collaborative healthcare settings.

# **Our Programs Support CSHP Members**

### **Research Grant Program**

To be eligible for a research grant, your proposed project should be in an area of research related to the pharmaceutical sciences or pharmacy practice.

A total of \$20,000 is allotted for funding research grants in 2021/22 competition year. A portion of these funds will be available for eligible research projects submitted by novice researchers. All grant applications, including novice researcher submissions, will be judged according to the criteria established for the CSHP Foundation Research Grant Competition. Grant funding awarded may not equal the total budget for the project.

### **Education Grant Programs**

#### **Education Grants**

Eligible education proposals will reflect CSHP members' innovative approaches to identifying or developing opportunities for professional education, dialogue and knowledge transfer for pharmacists.

A total of \$10,000 is allotted to fund education grants in 2021/22 competition year. The following grant types are available:

**Thematic Conferences Development:** organization of a targeted group which will focus on issues in pharmacy practice and/or education.

**Educational Programs or Materials for Pharmacists**: development of resources for pharmacists with a focus on optimizing pharmacotherapy

#### **Education Sabbatical Grants**

The CSHP Foundation offers dedicated funding up to a maximum of \$5,000 to support an Education Sabbatical Grant. Sabbatical Grants are offered in alternate years of the PLA Scholarship.

## CSHP Foundation Scholarship for the Pharmacy Leadership Academy Program

The CSHP Foundation is committed to offering educational opportunities that develop Canada's hospital pharmacy leaders using innovative, evidence-based methods. The **Pharmacy Leadership Academy®** (PLA) is a 12-month on-line integrated program offered by the ASHP Foundation that will appeal to Canadian hospital pharmacy leaders or those aspiring to leadership positions who want additional training. The PLA Scholarship (\$5,000 CDN) is offered in alternate years of the Education Sabbatical Grants.
