NOVA SCOTIA PHARMACY STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

Award Description	The NS Pharmacy Student Scholarship is presented to a pharmacy student who will enter their final year of the PharmD program at Dalhousie University (or other Canadian University) in September of this year and who demonstrates a marked interest in a career in hospital pharmacy. The Scholarship shall consist of one \$500 award. It is presented annually as resources allow. The award is intended to further the student's educational opportunities in their final year of pharmacy. This may include, but not be limited to, tuition expenses, reference books, journal subscriptions, educational meetings, etc.
Eligibility Criteria	The candidate must: 1. The student must be a current member of the NS Branch of CSHP. 2. A written application form must be submitted. 3. The successful applicant will be reimbursed upon submission of appropriate receipts to the NS Branch CSHP Treasurer. 4. The award must be used within a 1-year period.
Deadline for Applications	All applications are to be submitted to the Chairperson of the Awards Committee on/before a date determined by the CSHP Awards Committee.
Selection of Recipient	The Awards Committee will screen applicant submissions for completeness and appropriateness, and the Awards Committee members will make the final decision. The Awards Committee of the NS Branch of CSHP will notify the successful student, and the award will be presented, if possible, at the NS Branch CSHP Annual Awards Dinner.
Application	Available from Chairperson, Awards Committee and NS Branch CSHP website. The application includes: 1. A short written summary (maximum 500 words) describing: a) Your career plans after obtaining a PharmD degree. b) Your qualities and interests that could be of benefit to hospital pharmacy practice. c) The intended use of the scholarship. 2. Your curriculum vitae or resume.
